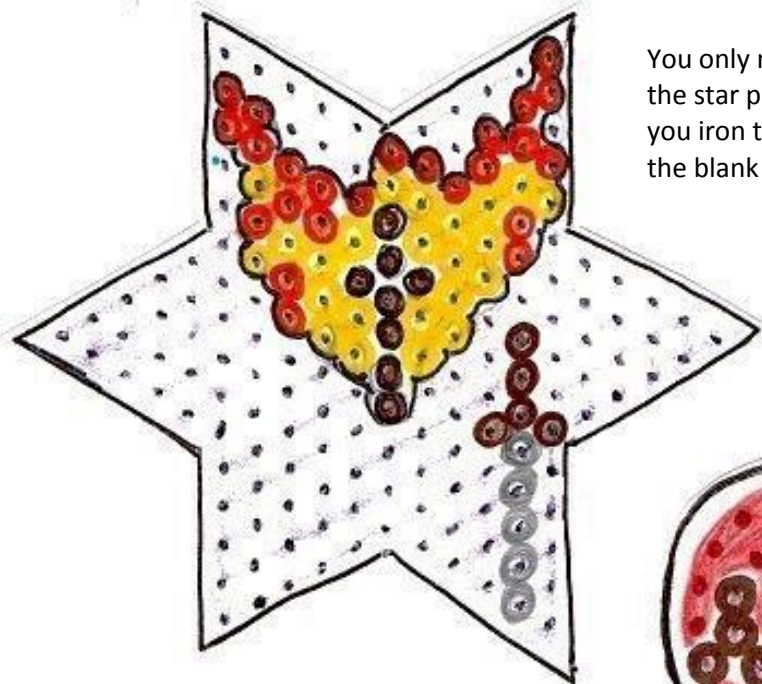
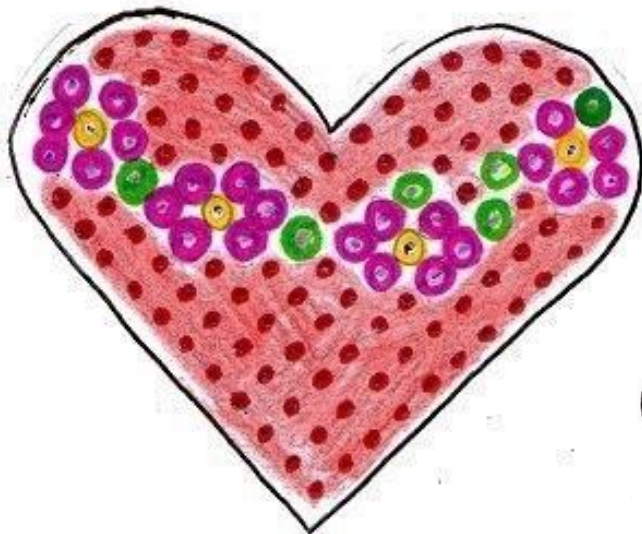
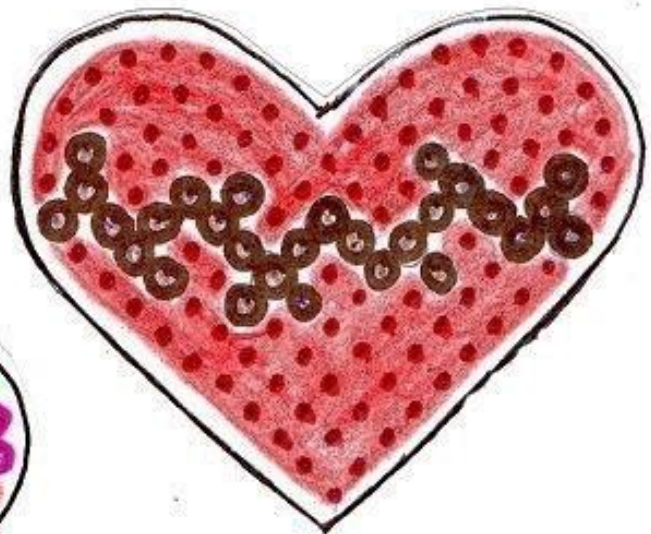


Sacred Heart and Immaculate Heart melting (Perler) bead pattern:

You will need to make two flames. The flame can be basically the same for both hearts, but for the Immaculate Heart take the cross out and make the area all yellow. (Different shades of yellow mixed together look nice. The sword is only for Our Lady's heart.



You only need to cover the colored spots of the star plate; the rest are empty. When you iron the beads, be careful not to melt the blank points of the star plate.



After they are melted, overlap the bottom of the flame and the top of the heart. Melt them again so they stick together.

Melt the parts just as the bead package directs. Then place the correct heart over top and matching flame. Sandwich the flame and heart between two melting/wax paper sheets and melt the two parts together with your iron; just as you would when you melt the beads. You may need to add more pressure on the iron to get them to stick together. Do the same with the sword. (These will only look nice from one side, so be sure you melt them so the nicer sides are on the good side. Visit www.catholicinspired.com for pictures and better directions.
